The Greater Kansas City Black History Study Group(**GKCBHSG**), a branch of The Association for the Study of African American Life and History(**ASALH**) will resume its Fall programming with the presentation of our Founder's Day Program on Saturday, September 21, 2024.

Mr. Rodney M. Thompson and Mr. W. Stinson McClindon, local independent filmmakers and documentarians will discuss their work with a video presentation featuring trailers and excerpts highlighting a wide variety of subjects including their efforts to document Kansas City's African American History. This topic continues our exploration of this year's ASALH theme, **African Americans and the Arts**. "Recognizing the dearth of information on the accomplishments of Blacks in 1915, Dr. Carter G. Founded in September 1915, ASALH branches gather each September to commemorate this milestone. Mindful of the numerous current attempts to suppress the teaching and learning of Black History across the country, the work of ASALH and its branches, is more crucial than ever.

What have you done to record and share the stories and/or genealogy information of your ancestors?

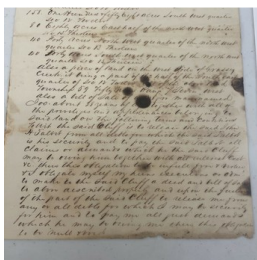
MAGIC collects your first page lineage charts!

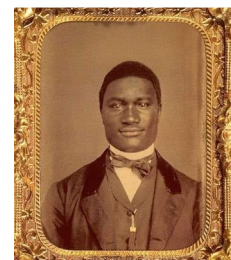
