## LINEAGE CHART IS A GREAT START

Below is an example of hand-made Lineage Chart #1 with 5 generations. It quickly and at a glance captures the names/dates/places of your DIRECT ancestors' birth/marriage/death dates. The names of great great grandparents go on the far right, and have a number next to each. That numeral indicates the subsequent chart where their details will be entered, so that the tree may 'grow' and 'branch' as more details may be uncovered.

**Don't worry about missing or blank entries on your chart...they are opportunities** for you to see where there are gaps needing further research.

These charts also help other genealogists quickly help give you pointers on what/where you might go next in your research.

You can also see migration patterns by studying the locations of each generation's birth, marriage and places of death.

**Fill-in, to the best of your ability and knowledge, your own Chart #1 and submit it to MAGIC for posterity. You can turn-in a printed chart at one of our meetings, surface mail to MAGIC's PO Box, or e-mail it to david.jackson@orderlypackrat.com.**

You never know who might see it and have an idea/s for you. Or, even more excitingly, a long-lost cousin may contact you who shares a common ancestor with you. And, they may have lots of information and photos passed down their line that you may have never seen!



## Souvenirs in a Box, old receipts, billings, and letters

Recently, I received a box of old family documents stored in an old shed on the family property in Mount Holly Springs, Pennsylvania. After the Civil War, formerly enslaved individuals and families settled in an African American community called Mount Tabor. One of the inhabitants, Elias V. Parker, was born enslaved around 1827 in Williamsport, Maryland.<sup>1</sup> A Civil War Veteran, Elias received a pension for a disability after the war.<sup>2</sup> My grandmother Harriet Parker (1891-1975)<sup>3</sup> and Elias and Lucinda's daughter would periodically tell stories about her mother and father; however, not much was shared about their daily lives. Viewing first-hand receipts from purchases made at local businesses dating from the 1880s through 1915 was insightful. I found grocery items, receipts for equipment, fabric, buttons, and the purchase of a heating- stove, along with nut coal as fuel. I did not realize that I would glean so much from land and tax receipts, grocery receipts, payment books, and letters.

Examining and cataloging these items helped me understand how my ancestors lived during the latter part of the nineteenth century. The artifacts are a history of the family's daily lives illustrating where they shopped, the various purchases, and the equipment and supplies needed to support their family.

Finding old letters written from my great-grandfather to my great-grandmother is of great significance. I learned more about his life as a brick mason and a builder. Holding an actual letter in my hands' one-hundred and twenty-two years following his death in 1898 was an enlightening experience. Below is the first page of one of the letters written on February 6, 1885.

 well at this time and I hope this will  
 find you well I am glad to hear you  
 say that you had such a pleasant  
 time in topper and I am also glad  
 that you have got a place in  
 Carlisle and I hope it may  
 be a good one I was a friend you  
 should go back to Jersey's gone

**The Church within the community**



The church organized educational endeavors, community betterment groups, benevolent societies, hosted social gatherings, and served as a catalyst for major political events. Newspaper articles announced church, plays, socials, and picnics.
